Game Rules

Objective

Become the best investor by correctly ranking the world's top companies according to their ESG (Environmental, Social, Governance) score. The first player to collect 10 cards wins the game!

What's included?

- 200 unique company cards with ESG information
- This instruction sheet

What is the ESG Score?

ESG stands for Environmental, Social, and Governance – it's a scoring system that evaluates a company's sustainability. The ESG score ranges from 0.5 to 100 – the higher the score, the more sustainable the company.

Card Anatomy


Front:

- Company name
- Logo
- ESG score

Back:

- Sector
- 1 positive ESG facts
- 1 negative ESG facts

How to Play

1. Shuffle the deck and deal 3 cards to each player. Players place their cards face-up, ordered by ESG score from lowest to highest.
2. One player draws a new card from the deck and reads aloud:
 - Company name
 - Sector
 - One positive and one negative ESG fact The ESG score is NOT revealed!
3. The player to the left guesses where to place the new card in their current lineup based on the provided information.
4. If guessed correctly – they keep the card, face up, in order.
5. If guessed incorrectly – the next player clockwise gets a chance to guess.
6. If no one guesses correctly after a full round – discard the card.
7. Continue playing until someone reaches 10 cards.

How to Win

The first player to collect 10 cards wins and earns the title of MASTER of INVESTMENTS!
